# Community Scholarships



## **AMERICAN LEGION SCHOLARSHIP**

The American Legion Scholarship is given to graduating Seniors who plan to attend a four-year college or university, community college, technical or professional school.

## **AMERICAN LEGION AUXILIARY SCHOLARSHIP**

The American Legion Auxiliary Scholarship is awarded to students who have demonstrated interest in service to the community through participation in extra-curricular activities, volunteerism, and have held membership in service organizations.

## **ARTHUR MCGAVRAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

The Arthur McGavran Scholarship was established in memory of Lieutenant Arthur McGavran who was killed in World War II, and is intended to assist a deserving graduate who desires to acquire technical training at a college or vocational school/program.

## **BANNER BANK SCHOLARSHIP**

The Banner Bank Scholarship is given to a graduating senior who plans to attend a four-year college or university or community college or technical or professional school.

## **BISHOP FLEET FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP**

The Bishop Fleet Foundation was founded on December 18, 1941 by Edward and Lillian Bishop and her brother, Reuben Fleet. This scholarship is given to a student attending a four-year college or university.

## **BOB BOYCE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship is given in memory of Bob Boyce, a long-time islander and a graduate of Friday Harbor High School. This award is given in recognition of achievement in athletics.

## **COLDWELL BANKER SAN JUAN ISLANDS SCHOLARSHIP**

The Coldwell Banker San Juan Islands Scholarship is given to students who have put forth outstanding effort academically throughout their high school career and have a sound plan for the future.

## **CONFIDENCE FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP**

The Confidence Scholarship, sponsored by the Whittier Foundation, was established to support students who have demonstrated a spirit of community service and academic scholarship.

## **CRYSTAL SEAS KAYAKING SCHOLARSHIP**

The Crystal Seas Kayaking Scholarship is given to graduating Seniors who plan to attend a four-year college or university, community college, technical or professional school.

## **EINAR NIELSEN-BECKY BARR MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

The Einar Nielsen-Becky Barr Memorial Scholarship is given to graduating Seniors who plan to attend a four-year college or university, community college, technical or professional school.

## **FRANK & MELISSA GUARD SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship is awarded to a student whom either through their college endeavors and/or through volunteer work are working to advance the well-being of youth.

## **FRIDAY HARBOR FIREFIGHTERS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP**

The Friday Harbor Firefighters Association Scholarship is given to graduating Seniors who plan to attend technical or vocational school.

## **FRIENDS OF MUSIC - BILL VAN ALLEN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

The Band Families and Friends Scholarship is given to students who have participated in the band program and are still actively involved. These scholarships are given in the name of Bill Van Allen.

## **INSKEEP LEGACY SCHOLARSHIP**

The Inskeep Legacy Fund was established through a generous gift from the estate of Jerry Inskeep, a longtime San Juan Island resident. His donation to the San Juan Island Community Foundation supports an ongoing scholarship program that provides college funding for graduating high school students on San Juan Island based upon financial need.

## **ISLAND ARTISANS ARTS SCHOLARSHIP**

Island Artisans is proud to award a scholarship to a graduating Senior who has demonstrated a superior aptitude in the visual arts and has expressed the importance of art in their life. The funds for this award are collected at the annual Holiday Art Market held at the Friday Harbor Elementary School during the Thanksgiving holiday.

## **JOHN VOLK MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

The San Juan Pilots Association has established this scholarship to provide financial assistance to students pursuing a career in an aviation related field.

## **KIWANIS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP**

The Kiwanis Club Scholarship is given to students who are responsible, dependable role models for others and exhibit good citizenship as documented by community service, a distinctive work record and/or scholastic achievement.

## **LOUIS A. COLEMAN AVIATION SCHOLARSHIP**

The Louis A. Coleman Scholarship is given to a graduating senior who is pursuing a career in any aspect of the aviation field and will attend a four-year college or university or community college or technical or professional school where the program is aviation focused.

## **LUXEL CORPORATION SCHOLARSHIP**

The Luxel Scholarship seeks to encourage further study in Science, Technology, Engineering or Math (STEM). The minimum requirements for the Luxel scholarship are a 3.5 cumulative GPA, the student must have been accepted into a 4-year university, and plan to major in a STEM area.

## **MARCIA ZAKARISON M.D. SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship is provided in the name of Dr. Marcia Zakarison, who believed that every young person should have an equal opportunity to receive the best education possible. The scholarship is offered to students pursuing a career in the healing arts and human medicine.

#### **NANA'S HOLIDAY HOUSE SCHOLARSHIP**

Nana's Holiday House was started as a place where kids could afford to buy Christmas gifts for their families and learn about the joy of giving. This scholarship is given to graduating Seniors who plan to attend a four-year college or university, community college, technical or professional school.

#### **PURPLE & GOLD SCHOLARSHIP**

The Purple and Gold Scholarship is given to a student who has earned a minimum GPA of 3.0 and participated in school-based activities with school spirit and school pride and in community service activities.

#### **SAN JUAN COUNTY SHERIFF'S GUILD SCHOLARSHIP**

The San Juan County Sheriff's Guild Scholarship is given to graduating Seniors who plan to attend a four-year college or university, community college, technical or professional school.

#### **SAN JUAN EDUCATION ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP**

The San Juan Education Association Scholarship is awarded to students who have demonstrated community involvement and citizenship as well as scholastic achievement.

#### **SAN JUAN EXCURSIONS SCHOLARSHIP**

The San Juan Excursions Scholarship is given to graduating Seniors who plan to attend a four-year college or university, community college, technical or professional school.

#### **SAN JUAN GOLF & TENNIS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP**

The Burrell Osburn & Bob Wingate Scholarship is given to students who have been a member of the High School Golf Team and exemplifies ethics in the game of golf.

#### **SAN JUAN INTERIORS SCHOLARSHIP**

The San Juan Interiors Scholarship is given to graduating Seniors who plan to attend a vocational or technical school.

#### **SAN JUAN ISLAND COMMUNITY FOUNDATION**

The San Juan Island Community Foundation Scholarship Fund provides scholarship awards for San Juan Island residents wishing to further their education at an accredited community college, two-year college, four-year university, or vocational/career program.

#### **SAN JUAN ISLAND PRESERVATION TRUST SCHOLARSHIP**

The San Juan Island Preservation Trust Scholarship is given to graduating Seniors who plan to attend a four-year college or university, community college, technical or professional school.

#### **SAN JUAN ISLAND RACQUET CLUB SCHOLARSHIP**

The San Juan Island Racquet Club Scholarship is given to graduating Seniors who were on the tennis team throughout high school and plan to attend a four-year college or university, community college, technical or professional school.

#### **SAN JUAN ISLAND SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP**

The San Juan Island Service Scholarship has two criteria: graduate from high school and volunteer for an average of 20 hours of community service each year of high school.

#### **SAN JUAN ISLANDS VISITORS BUREAU SCHOLARSHIP**

The San Juan Islands Visitors Bureau Scholarship is for students who will be attending a university or community college to earn a degree in Sustainable Tourism/Hospitality, Business Communications, Marketing, or an equivalent degree.

#### **SAN JUAN LION'S CLUB SCHOLARSHIP**

The Lion's Club motto is "We Serve." Lions vow to assist those who are less fortunate than themselves. These scholarships are presented to students who exemplify the spirit of Lionism.

#### **SAN JUAN MASONIC LODGE SCHOLARSHIP**

The San Juan Masonic Lodge Scholarship is given to graduating Seniors who plan to attend a four-year college or university, community college, technical or professional school. Consideration is given to academic achievement and the level of difficulty of classes taken in high school.

#### **SAN JUAN PROPERTY MANAGEMENT SCHOLARSHIP**

The San Juan Property Management Scholarship is given to graduating Seniors who plan to attend a four-year college or university, community college, technical or professional school.

#### **SOROPTIMISTS INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP**

The Soroptimists International Scholarship is given to female graduating Seniors who plan to attend a four-year college or university, community college, technical or professional school.

#### **STEM SOROPTIMISTS INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship is for young women embarking on a career in Science, Technology, Engineering or Math (STEM).

#### **TONY SURINA SCHOLARSHIP**
