

San Juan Island Public Schools Fall Reopening Plan

Hello to our school families!

The San Juan Island public schools will begin the 2020-2021 school year **on September 3** with a Teleschooling model. The district will review the plan after the first nine weeks to assess whether to bring students into the schools under a 'hybrid' model (half the students at a time on a rotating schedule), or to continue with Teleschooling.

To serve families for whom the Teleschooling schedule does not work, Griffin Bay School has been relaunched to support all grade levels. Younger students are now offered a "Remote Learning" model, defined as a program that allows for independent classroom work and study on the family's schedule, including a once a week check-in with an instructor. Materials will be provided by the school district.

Superintendent/Principal Fred Woods invites interested families to an informational "Zoom" meeting about new Griffin Bay School programs on Thursday, August 13, from 6:30 pm - 7:30 pm. This meeting will be "webinar style" and questions may be submitted through "chat".
