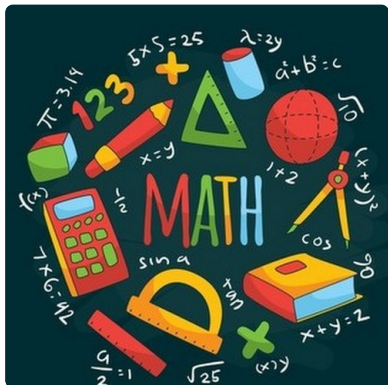


Picture Retakes

Math Club

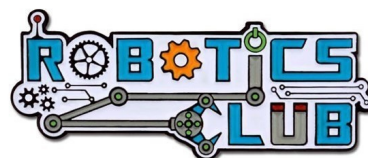
Mr. Lopez will be starting a Math Club that meets Monday's after school from 3-4. The club is free and is open to any students in grades 6,7,8 and 9.

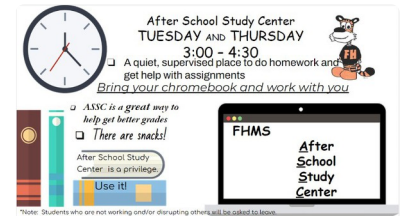
